






# STRATEGIC INITIATIVES

- **Partnerships**: Establish partnerships with local businesses and educational institutions to create a pipeline of talented interns and volunteers.




#### Fundraising and Community Outreach Initiative

Objective: Secure sustainable funding and increase community engagement to support the organization's programs and services. Actions:


- **Grant Writing Team**: Form a dedicated grant writing team to identify and apply for relevant grants from government agencies, foundations, and corporate sponsors.

These initiatives aim to address the immediate challenges while laying a strong foundation for long-term growth and sustainability.



In the heart of our community, Amazing Grace Community Resource Center has been a beacon of hope, providing crucial support to countless individuals and families. This past year, our centers in Jonesboro and Fayetteville welcomed 2,055 walk-ins, each seeking assistance, compassion, and a helping hand.

Through our dedicated efforts, we distributed 2,500 food boxes, ensuring that no one went hungry. Mondays became a day of nourishment and warmth as we served 9,983 families with fresh bread and pastries. Our Choice Program saw 30 enrollments, with 21 participants successfully completing the journey from January to December, finding new paths to stability and success.



We stood by our neighbors in their darkest hours, paying utility and other bills for 10 citizens, and providing temporary shelter through hotel assistance for 3 individuals. When rent and other needs arose, we referred 735 people to partner agencies, ensuring they received the help they needed.

The holiday season brought smiles to the faces of 165 children who received toys, while countless individuals received clothes to keep them warm. We also gave away 65 care boxes filled with essentials, and offered some form of case management to those navigating difficult circumstances.

These achievements are a testament to the incredible support of our donors and sponsors. Your prayers and financial contributions have been the lifeline that enables us to continue this vital work. As we look forward to 2025, we are reminded that it is through your unwavering support that we can anticipate even greater impact and transformation.

Thanks to the Clayton Police, Each of our youth received a Christmas scholarship of \$300 or more to shop with a privately assigned cop. This act of kindness was a big blessing and an honor for the kids.

**Fun and Fundraising**: Our Golf Fundraiser was more than a financial success; it was a day filled with fun and camaraderie as non-golfers enjoyed cruising in golf carts, thanks to our enthusiastic participants.

**Community Connections**: Our various events, including the Meet and Greet led by Lawyer Francis Kwafo (WFG), the Read 50 Books for \$50 summer campaign, and the heartfelt repass for Ms. Lisa Burns, brought our community closer together, fostering connections and shared experiences.

**Supporting Virtually**: The Choice Youth Empowerment program continued to thrive with Zoom meetings, and our Saturday Community Prayer sessions remained a beacon of unity and faith.

**Adapting to Challenges**: Despite the cancellation of our Community Back to School Bash at the park, we privately served those in need, ensuring that no one was left without support. Our Food and Clothing Banks saw an unprecedented increase in donations, providing more food and clothes than ever before.

**Spiritual Healing**: During our One-on-One with the Prophet sessions, countless souls found solace and deliverance through prayer and ministration, leaving with a sense of hope and spiritual renewal.

Through these stories of hope, love, and resilience, we are reminded of the profound difference we can make together. With your continued support, we can overcome challenges and create lasting change in our community.




#### A YEAR OF GENEROSITY AND NEED

#### BRIDGING THE GAP FOR A BRIGHTER FUTURE

As we reflect on the past year, Amazing Grace Community Resource Center is immensely grateful for the incredible generosity that has empowered us to serve our community. We have received significant financial support, in-kind donations, and grants that have made a world of difference

Thanks to the United Way's Learning Loss Grant, our Choice Youth Development Program received a much-needed boost of \$25,000. Clayton County's Community Block Grant provided an additional \$16,000 for our community outreach and youth development efforts. The Microsoft for Nonprofit grant continued to support us with \$30,000 worth of software and cloud services, enabling us to operate efficiently and effectively.

Individual donors, the heart and soul of our fundraising efforts, contributed \$13,026, and the Clayton Police generously gifted over \$5,000 in gift cards to our Choice Youth Development students for their "Shop with a Cop" initiative. Our partners at Atlanta Office Liquidators Inc. donated \$6,000 worth of furniture, ensuring that our spaces are welcoming and functional.



We are honored to have been recognized with a \$3,000 reward for winning the Nonprofit of the Year award at the Rising In Community Excellence (RISE) Awards. Our annual dinner fundraiser was another highlight, bringing in \$20,500 through the generous contributions of our supporters.

In total, we received \$199,873 in monetary and in-kind donations, a testament to the incredible support from our community. However, we still fell short of our \$255,000 target budget by over \$50,000.

The gap in our funding underscores the urgent need for continued and increased support. Every contribution, big or small, plays a crucial role in enabling us to bridge this gap and continue our mission. Your support will help us provide essential services, from youth development programs to food distribution and community outreach.


